LANCE FAMILY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Lance Family Foundation will provide a scholarship to an African-American Wayzata High School senior who has demonstrated academic achievement, leadership, and collegiate aspirations. This student must have a minimum 3.0 GPA (9.0 on a 12 pt. scale), must be attending an accredited 4-year college or university within six months of graduation, and must have demonstrated some leadership ability during their high school years.

The scholarship will be paid to the student during the WHS Senior Awards Recognition ceremony scheduled for May 2024.

The Lance Family Foundation Scholarship comes from the five Lance children, who all attended Wayzata High School: Harold Lance II, Class of '85, Adrienne Lance Lucas, Class of '86, Derrick Lance, Class of '89, Jonathan Lance, Class of '95, and Natisha Lance, Class of '99. Each of the Lance children credits their Wayzata education as being a pivotal part of their success. All five children graduated from 4-year colleges and two went on to receive graduate degrees from Ivy League institutions, The Harvard Business School and Columbia University Graduate School of Journalism. Their career paths span entrepreneurial ventures, real estate, news/journalism, and educational recruiting. In an effort to honor the diverse talents of the Lance family members, each year the criteria for the scholarship will be rotated based on one of the children's interests.
